



## **Stormwater Technician**

The City of Stockbridge has a job opportunity for a Stormwater Technician. This position is responsible for coordinating all activities within the City's Stormwater Utility, including system inventory, State reporting requirements, field inspections, repairs and maintenance to ensure compliance with local, state and federal environmental regulations.

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Conducts inspections, plan reviews and site surveys for stormwater runoff compliance requiring the use of GPS and other computer-based survey equipment;
- Compiles data and completes forms and reports as required by State and Federal regulations governing stormwater utilities; maintains electronic and physical records in organized filing system;
- Inspects all stormwater infrastructure in the City, including outfalls, detention and retention facilities and catch basins; identifies issues of non-compliance and coordinates maintenance and repair orders with Public Works department;
- Conducts routine sampling and testing of stormwater runoff for illicit discharges as required by Federal and State regulations using portable computerized testing devices; takes action to remediate any issues detected;
- Responds to calls regarding stormwater issues, investigates issues and coordinates remediation with Public Works, Water and Sewer departments; assists work crews as necessary;
- Performs other duties as assigned.

### **Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:**

- Knowledge of chemical treatment of groundwater;
- Knowledge of basic chemistry and biology;
- Skill operating a variety of water treatment and laboratory equipment;
- Skill operating a variety of tools, equipment and commercial vehicles;
- Ability to operate machinery requiring a high level of dexterity and perform duties in a variety of weather conditions;
- Ability to adhere to safe equipment operating procedures and respond to dangerous situations accordingly;
- Ability to make decisions and solve problems;
- Ability to work independently;
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with City officials, employees and the public;



- Ability to communicate effectively with co-workers and the general public.
- Skill operating a variety of tools, equipment and commercial vehicles.

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

Associate's degree or two (2) years of college or technical coursework supplemented by two (2) years of progressively responsible work experience in a related field; work experience operating hand tools and computer equipment; valid State of Georgia driver's license; Georgia Soil and Water Conservation Commission (GSWCC) Level 1A Fundamentals Stormwater Inspector certification; or any equivalent combination of education, training, and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills, and abilities for this job. Salary commensurate with experience.
