RESOLUTION NO. R16-706

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER AND USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS IN SUPPORT OF CAREER EXPO AND JOB FAIR AT THE MERLE MANDERS CONFERENCE CENTER**

WHEREAS, the City Council recently authorized, in partnership with Goodwill, an event linking Stockbridge residents who are seeking jobs with prospective employers;

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the career expo and job fair is in the best interest of the City and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council to provide for light refreshments for prospective employees seeking to employ Stockbridge residents;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

Section 1.     **Authorization of Refreshments** – The City Council of the City of Stockbridge hereby authorizes up to \$300 to be used to provide light refreshments at the above described career expo and job fair at the Merle Manders Conference Center.

Section 2.     **Transfer of Council Initiative Funds** – The City Council of the City of Stockbridge hereby directs the transfer of those City Council initiative funds allocated for Councilman Alexander to the governing body's miscellaneous fund account.


Section 3.     **Documents** – The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 4.     **Severability** - To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.


Section 5.     **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions** - All City resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SO RESOLVED, this the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2016.


