**RESOLUTION NO. R16-771**

**A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE STAFF TO ADVERTISE AND RECEIVE APPLICATIONS FOR PERSONS TO SERVE ON A YOUTH COUNCIL ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation located within Henry County, Georgia duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to residents located within the corporate limits of the City;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish a Youth Council to provide an opportunity for the youth of Stockbridge to build leadership skills, learn about civic responsibility, gain a better understanding of municipal government, prepare for a lifetime of public and community service and acquire a greater knowledge of and appreciation for the American political system;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish a Youth Council Advisory Board made up of adult volunteers to assist the City and its staff in creating a program and curriculum for the Youth Council;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary and desirable to advertise the Youth Council Advisory Board to the community and to seek volunteers willing to serve;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1.     **Youth Council Advisory Board** – The City staff is hereby authorized and directed to advertise vacancies on a Youth Council Advisory Board to be established by the City Council. The City Council invites interested adults to submit applications to serve on the board, the number of members and specific duties of which shall be established by the City Council in the near future.

Section 2.     **Documents** – The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3.     **Severability** - To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 4.     **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions** - All City resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5.     **Effective Date** - This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon the date of its adoption by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.




