RESOLUTION NO. R19-1036

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY STAFF TO EXPLORE ALTERNATIVE DESTINATION MARKETING ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation located within Henry County, Georgia duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to residents located within the corporate limits of the City;

WHEREAS, the Henry County Convention and Visitors Bureau provides destination marketing services to the City utilizing a portion of the City's Hotel-Motel Tax;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to consider an alternative destination marketing organization for the City;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. **Staff to Explore Alternative Destination Marketing Organization** – The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to work with the City staff and consultants to explore and present options for the City with respect to a destination marketing organization.

Section 2. **Documents** – The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3. **Severability** - To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 4. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions** - All City resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. **Effective Date** - This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon the date of its adoption by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.
