

RESOLUTION NO. 813-501

RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND SETTING FORTH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST SIGNATURES AND AFFIX THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE CITY, AS NECESSARY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to local residents; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.12.035 of the Stockbridge Code of Ordinances requires that the Mayor recommend qualified candidates for the position of City Administrator and the Mayor has recommended David Milliron as a qualified candidate for the position of City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the candidate recommended by the Mayor, and has determined that the Mayor's candidate possesses the correct qualifications, experience, skills, and familiarity with the operation of City of Stockbridge government for appointment to the position of City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.12.035 (B) of the Stockbridge Code of Ordinances requires that the Council employ a City Administrator pursuant to a written contract and fix the City Administrator's compensation therein; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.12.035 (C) of the Stockbridge Code of Ordinances provides that the City Administrator shall be the chief administrative officer for the City, shall devote all of his or her working time and attention to the affairs of the City, shall be responsible to the Mayor and City Council for the administration of all City affairs in his or her charge, and shall have certain delineated powers and duties under the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to compensate the City Administrator as provided for in the attached document until further action of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the foregoing appointment is necessary and beneficial to its citizens and to the efficient operation of the City.

THEREFORE, IT IS NOW RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Appointments.** The City Council hereby appoints David Milliron as the City Administrator pursuant to the provisions of Stockbridge Code of Ordinances Section 2.12.035 to be compensated at the rates described in the attached document and

approves the attached contract with the City Administrator.

2. **Approval of Execution.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any document which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.
3. **Severability.** To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.
4. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions.** All City resolutions are hereby repealed to the extent they are inconsistent with this Resolution.
5. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately.


