RESOLUTION NO. R13-502

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING Rhonda Blackman AS CITY CLERK, SETTING THE COMPENSATION AND DATE OF HIRE OF SAID CLERK, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSES OF THIS RESOLUTION, AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST SIGNATURES AND AFFIX THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE CITY, AS NECESSARY, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALING INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to residents located within the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter Section 4.13, the City Clerk shall be custodian of the official City seal, maintain City Council records, and perform such other duties as may be required by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the appointee shall perform the duties of the Clerk directly or supervise others under his/her supervision if approved by the City Council, and notwithstanding any delegation of duties, the appointee shall remain responsible for the duties assigned to him/her by the City Charter and the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter Section 4.13, the City Council desires to appoint Rhonda Blackman as the City Clerk, to be compensated at \$ 63,500 per year retroactive to January 1, 2013 subject to any amendments enacted by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the foregoing appointment is necessary and beneficial to its citizens and to the efficient operation of the City.

THEREFORE, IT IS NOW RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Approval** - The City Council of the City of Stockbridge, pursuant to its authority under Section 4.13 of the City Charter, hereby appoints Rhonda Blackmon as City Clerk of the City of Stockbridge. The City Clerk appointed hereunder shall begin employment on January 1, and shall be compensated in the amount of \$ 63,500 per year to be retroactive back to January 1, 2013.

Section 2. **Approval of Execution** - The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents and to perform all other acts necessary to effectuate this Resolution on behalf of the City of Stockbridge. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any document which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3. **Severability** - To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 4. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions** - All City resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. **Effective Date** - This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.
