RESOLUTION NO. 813-505

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING MAULDIN & JENKINS AS CITY AUDITOR, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSES OF THIS RESOLUTION, AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST SIGNATURES AND AFFIX THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE CITY, AS NECESSARY, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALING INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to residents located within the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter Section 6.29, the City is required to undergo an annual independent audit of all city accounts and financial transactions by a certified public accountant selected by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter Section 6.29, the audit is to be conducted according to generally accepted accounting principles, and copies of all audit reports are to be available at printing costs to the public; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said City Charter provisions, the City Council desires to appoint certified public accountants Mauldin & Jenkins as the City Auditor for 2013 due to the experience and expertise possessed by said accounting firm; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the foregoing appointment is necessary and beneficial to its citizens and to the efficient operation of the City.

THEREFORE, IT IS NOW RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Approval** - The City Council of the City of Stockbridge, pursuant to its authority under Section 6.29 of the City Charter, hereby appoints certified public accountants Mauldin & Jenkins as City Auditor of the City of Stockbridge for 2013.

Section 2. **Approval of Execution** - The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents and to perform all other acts necessary to effectuate this Resolution on behalf of the City of Stockbridge. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any document which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3. **Severability** - To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 4. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions** - All City resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. **Effective Date** - This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.
