RESOLUTION 2014 – B14-585

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ADOPT AN EMPLOYEE WELLNESS PROGRAM, TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL AGREEMENTS AND ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge (“City”) is a municipal corporation located within Henry County, Georgia duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to residents located within the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to enter into contracts for services with third parties pursuant to Charter Section 1.12(b)(7); and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is the best interest of the City to adopt an employee Wellness Program and implement the Wellness Surcharge.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. **Wellness Program** - The City Council of the City of Stockbridge hereby approves the implementation of the HealthWorks Wellness Program by Kaiser Permanente and the Wellness Surcharge of \$60.00 for those employees who do not meet the minimum participation requirements as provided for therein as outlined in Exhibit A-1 and A-2, respectively, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 2. **Approval of Execution** - The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents and to perform all other acts necessary to effectuate this Resolution on behalf of the City of Stockbridge. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any document which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3. **Severability** - To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 4. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions** - All City resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.


Section 5. **Effective Date** - This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the City Council as provided in the City Charter.


