RESOLUTION NO. - R13-549

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ADOPT THE ATTACHED SCHEDULE OF OCCUPATION TAXES, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSES OF THIS RESOLUTION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST SIGNATURES AND AFFIX THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE CITY, AS NECESSARY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation located within Henry County, Georgia duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to residents located within the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City assesses occupation taxes pursuant to Georgia law on businesses operating within the City of Stockbridge under appropriate circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the City's occupation tax code can be located at Sections 3.16.010 to 3.16.087 of the Stockbridge Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.16.080 of the Stockbridge Municipal Code provides that from time to time the Mayor and City Council shall adopt a schedule of business and occupation taxes, which are incorporated into Section 3.16.080 of the Stockbridge Municipal Code by reference; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.16.080 of the Stockbridge Municipal Code further provides that a current copy of the City's schedule of business and occupation tax is to be

maintained on file in the office of the City Clerk, where it shall be made available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update its schedule of business and occupation taxes by adopting the schedule of such taxes that is attached hereto as an exhibit; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council believe that the adoption of the attached schedule of business and occupation taxes will benefit the citizens and residents of the City, as well as the businesses herein; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to adopt the schedule of business and occupation taxes attached hereto, and to make said schedule available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. **Approval** - The City Council of the City of Stockbridge hereby approves and adopts the new schedule of business and occupation taxes attached hereto as an exhibit, and directs the City Clerk to maintain a copy of said schedule in her office as required by Section 3.16.080 of the Stockbridge Municipal Code.

Section 2. **Approval of Execution** - The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents and to perform all other acts necessary to effectuate this Resolution on behalf of the City of Stockbridge. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any document which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.



SO RESOLVED, this the 26th day of September, 2013.


