RESOLUTION NO. R13-526

A RESOLUTION SEEKING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING FOR A COMMUNITY POOL, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSES OF THIS RESOLUTION, AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST SIGNATURES AND AFFIX THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE CITY, AS NECESSARY, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALING INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation located within Henry County, Georgia duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to residents located within the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, Henry County, Georgia was designated by State and/or federal authorities as an entitlement community eligible for CDBG funds following the 2010 census; and

WHEREAS, Georgia law provides that cities are authorized to participate in Community Development Block Grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the cities of Stockbridge, McDonough, Locust Grove, and Hampton entered into a joint agreement with Henry County to collaboratively apply for CDBG funds; and

WHEREAS, Henry County has informed the municipalities that they may apply for allocation of said CDBG funds with an eligible project by submitting an application on or before April 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge timely submitted the aforementioned application.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. **Approval** - The City Council of the City of Stockbridge hereby formally requests funds in the amount of \$150,000.00 to assist with the design and construction of a community swimming pool, and commits that the remaining funds for the construction of said community pool will come from the general funds of the City of Stockbridge and/or other available resources.

Section 2. **Approval of Execution** - The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 3. **Documents** - The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.


Section 4. **Severability** - To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or non-binding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 5. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions** - All City resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 6. **Effective Date** - This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.
