

RESOLUTION NO. R13-547

RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE CITY TREASURER; AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE TO OPEN BANK ACCOUNTS WITH BANKING INSTITUTIONS AUTHORIZED TO DO BUSINESS IN THE STATE OF GEORGIA; DESIGNATING CERTAIN PERSONS AS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN CHECKS ON THE CITY'S BEHALF; AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST SIGNATURES AND AFFIX THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE CITY, AS NECESSARY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to local residents; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.14 of the City Charter, the City Council desires to appoint Mike Bush as the City Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.14 of the City Charter, the appointee shall collect all taxes, licenses, fees, and other moneys belonging to the City subject to the provisions of the Charter and the ordinances of the City and to enforce all laws of Georgia relating to the collection of delinquent taxes and sale or foreclosure for nonpayment of taxes to the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.14 of the City Charter, the appointee shall further perform such other duties as may be required by the City Council and shall be compensated as instructed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.14 of the City Charter, the appointee shall further be responsible for the general duties of a treasurer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.14 of the City Charter, the appointee shall perform the aforementioned duties directly or supervise others under her supervision if approved by the City Council, and notwithstanding any delegation of duties, the appointee shall remain responsible for the duties assigned to her by the City Charter and the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4.14 of the City Charter, the City Council shall provide for the compensation of the City Treasurer to be \$ 89,000 per year subject to any amendments enacted by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the foregoing appointment is necessary and beneficial to its citizens and to the efficient operation of the City; and

WHEREAS, from time to time the City is required to open and maintain bank accounts of all nature including but not limited to checking, savings, escrow, and trust accounts pursuant to Section 3.04.030 of the City Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, banking institutions require that a resolution be duly adopted by the City Council authorizing the opening and management of the account; and

WHEREAS, banking institutions also require that a resolution be duly adopted by the City Council naming certain persons to be authorized to execute documents related to each said account; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that a Resolution authorizing the City to open bank accounts and to designate authorized signatories is necessary and beneficial to its citizens and to the proper use of City funds, and that such a Resolution is appropriate at this time due to the appointment of a new City Treasurer.

THEREFORE, IT IS NOW RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Appointments.** The City Council hereby appoints Mike Bush as the City Treasurer. The City Treasurer shall serve as the Chief Fiscal Officer for the City.
2. **Authorization.** - The Mayor, City Treasurer, City Manager, Chairman of the Finance Committee, and City Clerk, as designated below, are hereby authorized to open such bank accounts and sign checks as may be needed by the City to conduct the business of the City and in accordance with Section 3.04.030 of the City Code of Ordinances.

6. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the City Council and Mayor as provided in the City Charter.


