

RESOLUTION NO. 14-603

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE (HEREINAFTER REFFERED TO AS "CITY") TO EXECUTE SERVICE DELIVERY AGREEMENTS; TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST SIGNATURES AND AFFIX THE OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE CITY, AS NECESSARY; TO REPEAL INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with providing public services to local residents; and

WHEREAS, the City executed Service Delivery Strategies ("SDS Agreements") with Henry County in 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to authorize the Mayor to negotiate new SDS Agreements with Henry County.

THEREFORE, IT IS NOW RESOVLED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:


1. **Approval of Execution.** That the Stockbridge City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to negotiate and to execute new SDS Agreements with Henry County.
2. **Documents.** That the Stockbridge City Council authorizes to City Clerk to execute, attest and seal any documents which may be necessary to effectuate this Resolution.
3. **City Attorney.** All SDS documents are subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.
4. **Severability.** To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or nonbinding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.
5. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions.** All City Resolutions are hereby repealed to the extent they are inconsistent with this Resolution.
6. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
