

RESOLUTION NO. 14-609

A RESOLUTION TO UTILIZE FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND RESERVE ACCOUNT TO PAY FOR THE REIMBURSABLE CONSTRUCTION COSTS FOR THE REEVES CREEK TRAIL, PHASE 2 PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Stockbridge ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with being fiscally responsible concerning the use and expenditure of all public funds, and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the tremendous benefits associated with the development of a trail network for both pedestrians and bicycles to promote both a health and wellness and as well as economic development, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously approved the construction of Reeves Creek Trail, Phase 2 project, utilizing Transportation Enhancement (TE) grant funds, which required the City to provide a 20% match, equating to \$104,000 and which was paid in the previous fiscal year (2013), and;

WHEREAS, the remaining \$416,000 in construction costs will be paid by the Georgia Department of Transportation, however, the City must first pay these cost, and then submit for reimbursement.

THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKBRIDGE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Funds from the city's general fund reserve account may be used to pay the construction costs for this project, and all reimbursement funds will be returned back into this same account.

SECTION 1. Public Record. This document shall be maintained as a public record by the City Clerk and shall be accessible to the public during all normal business hours of the City of Stockbridge.


SECTION 2. Approval of Execution. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 3. Attestation. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents which may be necessary to effectuate this ordinance, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Stockbridge as provided in the City Charter.
